Their little minds grasp more than we think! Let's come together and ask God to give them a fresh look at his goodness and mercy that follows them every day of their lives.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

These cards are designed to be simple to use. Just print and cut out the number you need for your Thanksgiving meal, pass around a bowl or hat, and have everyone draw one question card to answer.

Consider reading both the question and the scripture on each card aloud. As kids share their answers, encourage them to practice giving thanks to God for whatever they have answered to help them remember that every good gift is from above!
